# AIA Tri-State Design Awards 2024 CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

Regionally compete with your peers from AIA New Jersey, AIA New York State, and AIA Pennsylvania to be honored for architectural excellence!

The AIA Tri-State Design Awards will be celebrated November 19, 2024, in conjunction with the Tri-State Fusion Conference, formerly the AIA Tri-State Conference, set for November 18-20, 2024 in Hershey.

The AIA Tri-State Design Awards is accepting eligible project submissions for the 2024 program through 11:59 pm Sunday, October 13, 2024.

All entries will be featured in the AIA Tri-State Design Awards Showcase Gallery. Finalists and recipients will be tagged in the showcase. Recipients will also be recognized in a nationally distributed press release, and state chapters' announcements and media outreach. Finalists are projects that advance to the final jury round. Recipients are projects that are chosen for awards in the final jury round.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

A project may be submitted, provided the project and its submitting firm/architect adhere to the following criteria.

#### SUBMITTING FIRM

The submitting firm must be the Architect of Record\* and/or the Design Architect. In the case of multi-office firms, eligible projects are limited to work done primarily by the PA, NY, or NJ-based office as the Architect of Record and/or Design Architect.

#### **AIA MEMBERSHIP**

The submitting firm, as Architect of Record and/or Design Architect, must have at least one Principal who is a current AIA Pennsylvania, AIA New Jersey, or AIA New York State architect member.

#### STATE AWARDS PROJECT ENTRY

Eligibility is restricted to projects entered in AIA New Jersey, AIA New York State, or AIA Pennsylvania Design Awards programs in 2024, 2023, or 2022.

Please note that projects that have previously been recognized with an award by the AIA Tri-State Design Awards program are not eligible for resubmittal in whole or in part. This also applies to projects that have already received recognition by the AIA Tri-State Design Awards as an un-built project.

# **ENTRY FEE**

The cost per project entry for 2024's program is \$100.

# PROJECT CATEGORIES

Projects may only be submitted in one category. Please use your discretion to submit the project in the category that you feel best represents the project. The jury has the discretion to recategorize projects if they deem the project more worthy of assessment or recognition in another category.

#### **ARCHITECTURE**

Built projects including new buildings of all types including additions and alterations to existing buildings including but not limited to commercial, institutional, mixed-use, multifamily, and educational projects.

#### **IMPACT DESIGN**

Projects that exemplify the power of design to create a better world. Impact Design Projects will be evaluated for their service to the public good, especially in disadvantaged communities. Examples include initiatives, events, and products specifically designed to positively impact the social, environmental, and economic fabric of communities.

#### INTERIOR ARCHITECTURE

Interiors, large or small in scope, and may involve new construction, renovation, and preservation or restoration projects, that focus on interior space.

#### PRESERVATION ARCHITECTURE

Projects including historic preservation, historic restoration, historic rehabilitation, reconstruction, and adaptive reuse.

### **REGIONAL AND URBAN DESIGN**

Recognizes the best in urban design, regional and city planning, and community development.

#### SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DESIGN

Single-family residences, accessory buildings or Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADUs), and additions.

## SMALL PROJECT // UNDER \$500,000

Small project construction, object, work of environmental art or architectural design under \$500,000 in construction cost.

#### **SMALL PROJECT // UNDER 1.5 MILLION**

Small project construction under 1.5 million in construction cost.

#### SMALL PROJECT // UNDER 3,000 SQUARE FEET

Small project construction, object, work of environmental art or architectural design under 3,000 square feet.

#### **UN-BUILT**

Projects yet to be realized or canceled (speculative work, conceptual work, competition work, etc.).

The "Project Information Page" should include a narrative project overview addressing the context or scope of the project, its use, design process, key interventions, benefits, and outcomes for client, occupants, or community. The project narratives from the "Project Information" portion of this submission can be repurposed or repeated on the "Project Information Page." This may be a composite page.

Required landscape layout (11x8.5") or preferably widescreen layout (16:9 aspect ratio; 1920x1080 pixels). PDF documents are the only acceptable document type.

You are encouraged to include repeats of any of the photos/rendering or architectural plans uploaded to the "Project Photos & Architectural Plans" portion of the submission. The remaining pages of the binder may include any combination of text/copy and images that best illustrates the project's process, features, and impact.

May be granted, at the jury's discretion to projects that exemplify distinguished achievement in any category.

#### **MERIT AWARD**

May be granted, at the jury's discretion to any project that either lies outside of the other categories or bears an exceptional aspect that the jury feels represents excellence which deserves recognition.
