2025 Architecture Week Celebration

AIA PA celebrated Architecture Week (April 13-29) 2025 by sharing examples of architectural excellence at the state capitol and inspiring young minds to design and create animal communities.

From April 14-24th, the PA State Capitol's main rotunda was host to our Architecture Week exhibit. The centerpiece of the exhibit was a Pennsylvania state map with QR code pointers highlighting the projects and firms who won our 2024 Design and COTE awards. These QR codes led visitors to our member firm's websites highlighting the individual projects, their vision, the history of the project, and their innovative designs. The PA State Capitol itself was the winner of the 50 Year Timeless award and our exhibit included our beautifully shot and narrated video celebrating Pennsylvania's "Palace of Art".

Our own, Amyra Weiss - Chief Communications Visionary and Storyteller, brought Architecture Week to her daughter's kindergarten classroom. Inspired by AIA Kansas City's animal dice game, Amyra guided the class through designing two <u>communities</u>, which included libraries for snakes, hotels for monkeys, schools for fish, homes for penguins and more. The children were prompted to think about the client's needs, their environment,

and the connections between the structures and the surrounding communities. We also shared several resources with the Pennsylvania county library systems to provide opportunities for children of all ages to learn more about architecture and ACE career possibilities.

Our Architecture Week celebrations provided for thousands of people and students to see the amazing work of our members and to appreciate the importance of architects in creating our built environment. We encourage all of our members to share our available Architecture Week <u>resources</u> with their network to inspire the next generation of architects.
